

Quick Access Toolbar Setup


The Quick Access Toolbar, located in the upper left corner of Excel, allows you add commands for easy access. To customize, select **File**, then **Options**, and click on **Quick Access Toolbar**. Change the command list from *Popular Commands* to *All Commands*, then select the commands you want to add. Commonly added Cause Mapping commands are shown to the right.



3 Key Functions You Should Know

Control-Drag (copy shortcut)

To copy and paste a new box, left-click on the border of an existing box. While holding the click, drag the box to the desired location. Before releasing the left mouse button, hold down the Ctrl key. Release the left click before releasing the Ctrl key.





Connector Alt Shortcut

Pressing the Alt key in Excel activates keyboard shortcuts for the Quick Access Toolbar. Tap and release Alt to display shortcut numbers for each command.

NOTE: Connector: Elbow Arrow in 1 position



If the Connector: Elbow Arrow is in the 1 position, then tapping the 1 key will immediately select a connector that can be used to connect boxes.







Select Objects Cursor

The select objects cursor allows you to select objects. For easy access, add this function to your Quick Access Toolbar (see above). To select multiple objects, left-click and drag in open space to create a selection window—only objects fully inside the shaded area will be selected.

Other Useful Functions

Move Boxes in a Straight Line

To move boxes in a straight line, hold the **Shift** key while dragging the box. This restricts movement to 90-degree angles (left, right, up, or down). You can also use this method when copying objects to keep them aligned (**Ctrl-Shift-Drag**).

Align Multiple Boxes

To align multiple objects, select them using the Select Objects cursor or by holding down the Shift key while selecting. Once selected, click the alignment command of your choice.

Tip: Be sure not to select any connectors, as they will align along with the objects.

Zoom with Control-Scroll

To quickly zoom in and out, hold the **Ctrl** key and scroll up or down with the mouse wheel.
